

Sports Premium Spending Plan 2021-2022

Sports premium budget of £16,000 plus £10 per each pupil (£500). £16,520.

There has also been some additional carry over from previous years due to Covid.

OnSide Sports	£75 per week for 3 hour session (including after school club) = £2925	All school year. Half clubs free for children to increase participation. Club linked to cluster events to provide opportunities to practise skills.
Inter Schools competitions delivery and organisation	£820	Cartmel Priory to employ member of staff for ½ day a week.
Cluster Commonwealth Games on 6 th July.	£540	£10 per head for each child to attend the games. Children tried new sports, competed competitively and worked as a team.
Gymnastics Coaching – Jenny Cooper	£541	Specialist coaching across school to build skills and support children in learning Key Steps Gymnastics routines. CPD for staff.
Acrobatic and Movement with Jayne from Rigney Bank Ballet	£720	Coaching to develop movement to music, listening skills, expression and simple gymnastics to all children in school.
Tower Wood Outdoor Education Centre	£1750 COACH - £360 <u>£2110</u>	Whole school full day of activities to improve resilience, provide challenge and promote teamwork, developing skills from last year.
Cumbria Cricket coaching sessions	£540	18 hours of coaching for all children and an afterschool club. Developing on last years skills and preparing for cluster competition.
Judo with Danny Harper	£720	New sport and skills introduced to the children. Whole school coaching and after school club.
Playground equipment and resources	£2200	New equipment to encourage children to be active at playtimes, try new activities, encourage teamwork and allow older playleaders to develop confidence and leadership.
Outdoor storage sheds	£1800	Large outdoor sheds to store equipment to promote games and practise skills at lunchtimes.
EYFS Bikes and Trikes	£1000	New bikes, scooters and trikes for early years to support gross motor development.
EYFS Fine motor activities	£80	Toys and games to support EYFS development of fine motor skills.

Additional staffing costs to facilitate participation and attendance to events, training and competitions.	£1500	Children are safe and supported and able to attend festivals in our cluster.
Mindfulness Books	£100	To supplement the health and wellbeing aspect of our PE teaching.

Total £15,596

The remainder is being used to purchase a range of new equipment to support health, wellbeing and development for our EYFS children in their outdoor area and upkeep, maintenance and development of our outdoor equipment by the hall/classroom for playtimes.
